Article I Section 12

Applicability: Process bath disposal.

Purpose: Ensure the proper disposal of process rinse water.

Person or Department Responsible: EETD Laboratory Assistant

Schedule: Once per year

Procedure: The rinse water from the process is collected in a 55 gallon

drum in the room below the process area. The EETD Lab Assistant will monitor the level in the drum and notify the Director of Environmental Health & Safety when the drum is 80% full. The Director will make arrangements with the College approved and licensed hazardous waste vendor for a drum change out. A waste determination and analytical testing will be done by the Director of EHS prior to drum removal. No rinse waters will be discharged to the drain unless the Director of EHS has had confirmation from the County Sewer District, based on the analytical testing.
