Purpose:	Ensure that waste-cooking oil is managed properly

Procedures:	Waste-cooking oil will be placed in the original container and labeled, "Waste Cooking Oil". The containers will be placed on a spill pallet to ensure grease spillage is contained. The containers must remain in good condition, leak proof, and kept closed except when adding grease.
	Spills of grease to sanitary and storm drains must be prevented. Any spills or leaks out of the spill pallet should be cleaned up immediately to maintain sanitary conditions and prevent oil from reaching the storm or sanitary sewer systems.
	When enough waste cooking oil containers have accumulated, the Associate Coordinator of Business Services will have them transported to the vendor's facility in Albany, NY.
