Applicability:	Waste cooking oil / grease
Purpose:	Ensure that waste-cooking oil is managed properly
Person or Department Responsible:	Chartwells Manager
Schedule:	As needed
Procedures:	Waste-cooking oil will be transferred in a covered container from the kitchen to the containers labeled "Waste Cooking Oil" in the rear of the Campus Center, outside of the dock area. Care will be taken not to spill grease when pouring into the waste drum. The drums and containment system must remain in good condition, leak proof, and kept closed except when adding grease. The drums will remain on the spill containment to ensure grease spillage is contained. Spills of grease to sanitary and storm drains must be prevented. Any spills or leaks outside of the containment area should be cleaned up immediately to maintain sanitary conditions and prevent oil from reaching the storm or sanitary sewer systems. When the grease drums are close to full, the Chartwells Manager will make arrangements for a pickup by the grease rendering contractor.
Record keeping:	A copy of waste pickup documentation should be retained to document the periodic waste collection.
