** If a student is already registered and adds another course to his or her schedule, a student is automatically registered for that course and has incurred tuition liability. The course will not be dropped for non-payment.

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Payment - A student's tuition & fees must be received by the due date of the earliest scheduled Part of Term. **All courses** on a student's schedule will be dropped for non-payment if the student is not paid in full by the tuition due date of the earliest scheduled Part of Term. All registration activity will cease at the close of business the day of a schedule drop and will reopen the next business day.

****If a student is already registered and adds another course to his or her schedule, a student is automatically registered for that course and has incurred tuition liability. The course will not be dropped for non-payment.**

Web Registration – Begins Thursday, **March 17, 2016** – Through advisement, students will obtain an AVN that will allow registration access for Fall 2016, via the web.

Non-Matriculated Student Registration – Begins Thursday, **March 17, 2016** - Non-Matriculated students may register at the Registrar's Office or seek advisement (AVN distribution) through the Office of Continuing Education.

Phone Registration – Begins Thursday, **March 17, 2016** – Open to all non-matriculated students: (518) 629-4560.

Add/Drop Period – Students who are already registered may adjust times and courses during this time period (**but not via WIREd**). The Registrar's Office can only adjust days & times for matriculated students; all other changes must be done by an advisor. Non-matriculated students can contact Registrar's Office or seek advisement through the Office of Continuing Education.

Late Registration Fee – This fee automatically appears on a student's bill if he or she is registering for the first time during late registration.

Refunds are initiated automatically and are generated based on schedule adjustments and refund deadlines (as indicated on the Registration Calendar). Refunds are processed by the Cashier's Office within 10 business days.

Course Audits for Senior Citizens (ZSR) - Hudson Valley Community College offers to senior citizens who are at least 60 years of age the opportunity to audit credit bearing courses. There are no tuition charges; however, the students will be responsible for the payment of fees. College credit will not be granted for auditing a course. Registration is based on space availability and is held the Friday prior to the start of the specific course. The Arts Center courses may also be audited; however, the Center must be contacted directly.

Hudson Mohawk Cross-Registration Agreement - The first day students from other consortium colleges will be allowed to register for classes is the Wednesday after classes have begun for each part of term (please see registration calendars for the start date of each part of term). Those students who opt to initially register as a non-matriculated student will not be allowed to transfer their registration to a cross-registration status thereafter. A cross-registration form, complete with the designated home school official signature, must be presented at the time of registration. Visiting students are responsible for all related fees. Students may not cross-register for courses taught through The Arts Center.

SUNY Cross-Registration Agreement - The first day students from other SUNY four-year institutions or community colleges will be allowed to register for classes is **June 30, 2016**. Those students who opt to initially register as a non-matriculated student will not be allowed to transfer their registration to a cross-registration status thereafter. A SUNY cross-registration form, complete with the designated home school official signature, must be presented at the time of registration.

Student schedules: Class schedules can be accessed via Hudson Valley WIREd upon scheduling for courses. A printed schedule may be picked up in-person by the student only, once the student has paid his or her bill starting in the first week of August. Class schedules are no longer mailed.

AVN Distribution begins: Monday, February 15, 2016
Registration Begins: Thursday, March 17, 2016
New Student Orientations Begin: Monday, April 4, 2016
Course Reserve Drop Date: Friday, July 1, 2016 – *The reserve drop will take place at 4 p.m. and registration will remain off until 8 a.m. the next business day.*

Commitment Date: Friday, July 1, 2016 – *Students who schedule classes on or before July 1 for the fall semester must pay a \$50 tuition deposit to demonstrate their commitment to attend the college in the fall. Matriculated students may also meet this requirement if a FAFSA has been filed by June 17 with Hudson Valley Community College for the upcoming academic year. Students who have not satisfied this requirement by 4 p.m. on July 1 will have their class schedules dropped.*

Certificate Of Residence Requirement: Certificates for Fall 2016 must be dated no earlier than June 30, 2016 for on-campus day classes. Certificates of Residence are valid only if issued within 60 days prior to the start of classes.
