MODIFICATION TO BOARD BYLAWS

Resolved, that the request to amend Article 2, Section 2.4, Paragraph C of the Board of Trustees Bylaws and Policy Manual, be and hereby is, approved, as follows:

C. Restricted to such subject areas, consideration of a probationary Instructor for tenure and promotion to Assistant Professor shall not be premised upon attainment of the next higher degree in addition to satisfactory service during the probationary period. In all other respects, the decision to award tenure shall comply with established protocol. Since all rank beyond Assistant Professor is a function of College discretion, the President of the College shall have the discretion to approve further rank progression without the attainment of a Master's degree, based on compliance with the Discretionary Promotion protocol as established by the Academic Senate.
