<ul> <li>Vocational Rehabilitation</li> <li>Must have served on or after September 16, 1940</li> <li>Service-connected disabilities must be rated at least 20% disabling</li> </ul>	Case Manager: Jason Peryea 518-626-5693
<ul> <li>NYS Veterans Tuition Award (VTA)*</li> <li>Payable to eligible veteran students</li> <li>Must be matriculated at an institution in NYS</li> </ul>	www.hesc.ny.gov • roll over Pay • click Military
<ul> <li>Recruitment Incentive and Retention Program (RIRP)*</li> <li>Must be an active member of the NYS Division of Military and Naval Affairs</li> <li>Must be matriculated in a degree program</li> <li>Must have successfully completed advanced individual training or commissioning and other requirements for tuition benefit eligibility</li> </ul>	<ul><li>dmna.ny.gov</li><li>roll over For Members</li><li>click Education Services</li><li>roll over Tuition Assistance</li></ul>
<ul> <li>Military Active Duty Scholarship*</li> <li>Must be currently on active duty and meet eligibility criteria for Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA)</li> <li>Pays tuition only for courses required for program</li> <li>Credit for Military Training</li> <li>Receive credit toward a degree for military training</li> <li>Must submit an official military transcript to the Admission's Office</li> </ul>	Hudson Valley Registrar's Office 518-629-4574
